Privacy Policy

tutorlet ("we," "our," or "us") is committed to protecting your privacy. This Privacy Policy explains how your personal information is collected, used, and disclosed by **tutorlet**. This Privacy Policy applies to our application named **tutorlet**, and its associated subdomains (collectively, our "Service"). By accessing or using our Service, you signify that you have read, understood, and agree to our collection, storage, use, and disclosure of your personal information as described in this Privacy Policy and our Terms of Service.

Definitions and key terms

• Cookie: small amount of data generated by a website and saved by your web browser. It is used to identify your browser, provide analytics, remember information about you such as your language preference or login information.

• Company: when this policy mentions "Company," "we," "us," or "our," it refers to SchoolPaths Ghana, that is responsible for your information under this Privacy Policy.

• Country: where **tutorlet** or the owners/founders of **tutorlet** are based, in this case is Ghana.

• Customer: refers to the company, organization or person that signs up to use the **tutorlet** Service to manage the relationships with your consumers or service users.

• Device: any internet connected device such as a phone, tablet, computer or any other device that can be used to visit **tutorlet** and use the services.

• IP address: Every device connected to the Internet is assigned a number known as an Internet protocol (IP) address. These numbers are usually assigned in geographic blocks. An IP address can often be used to identify the location from which a device is connecting to the Internet.
